TPMC REACHES SAFETY MILESTONE

DOE contractor reaches 500,000 safe work hours

PIKETON, Ohio - Theta Pro2Serve Management Company (TPMC) recently celebrated 500,000 work hours without a lost work day due to injury. The achievement represents more than two years without a significant injury.

“We are extraordinarily proud of this milestone because safety is one of the staples of any company’s mission and a key barometer of performance,” said TPMC President Mike Logan. “This achievement was made possible by the dedicated employees on our staff and the fact that safety is woven into our culture.”

TPMC is the infrastructure contractor for the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) at the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant in Piketon, Ohio, and has been recognized as a “Star” company in DOE’s Voluntary Protection Program.

The Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant is a DOE-managed, contractor-operated site of 3,777 acres, within a seven-mile perimeter. It was built in the early 1950s as part of the nation’s nuclear weapons complex. Uranium was enriched from 1954-2001 and is today part of the world’s largest cleanup program under DOE’s Office of Environmental Management.
